

SAVA CHILD ACTIVITIES VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

- JOB TITLE:** Child Activities Volunteer
- PURPOSE:** Child Activities Volunteers offer support, supervision and engagement to children of SAVA clients while they attend groups in Larimer and Weld Counties. Volunteers provide children with age-appropriate and nurturing play-experiences within a safe and positive space for the duration that their caregiver is in group.
- REPORTS TO:** Bilingual Victim Services Coordinators, Volunteer and Direct Service Coordinators
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** Uphold SAVA Guidelines for Child Activities Volunteers. Commit to volunteer at least once per month.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Over 18 years of age; able to work shifts; possesses an open, non-judgmental attitude toward sexual assault survivors; enjoys working with diverse populations; good communication skills; able to work well with a wide range of people; has some experience working with children in either a personal (i.e. babysitting) or professional setting. Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred; CPR/First Aid certified preferred.
- SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** Complete 1-hour training on SAVA and its services; pass a background check; commit to 3 months with program; sign and uphold SAVA Guidelines
- BENEFITS:** Volunteers will be able to gain experience working with children while creating and planning their own activities to support their growth and development. Participation will help SAVA clients receive the services they need that they otherwise could not receive.
